April Practicum Month for Psychic Exercises

You'll also participate in practice sessions with other students from another circle, each offering a unique opportunity to expand your experiences and strengthen your skills. Post-session, you'll reflect on and conduct a thoughtful analysis of your experiences, using specially designed analysis sheets to record and evaluate your progress, which you'll submit to your teacher for feedback.

Part II: Exploring the Spirit World & the Ethics of Communication

Unit 4: Uncovering Death's Mysteries to Enhance Life's Journey

- Receive a complete awareness of what happens when the body dies and the soul and spirit move on, as well as how to develop effective communication

- Gain an awareness of your soul's ability to quiet your mind
- Allow the **spirit world** to speak directly to their loved ones
- Develop practices to **build links** with the spirit world
- **Observe** other working mediums
